





What do we offer ?

1. Regular thematic challenges and permanently running «Open Innovation Challenge» for you to participate in on <https://innobooster.org>.
2. Winning teams from Gate 1 (Jury Decision) can claim **CHF 17'000** for Idea Testing & Validation.
3. In the Project Fabric Phase, teams are actively being coached.
4. Gate 2: After about 6 months, the innovation teams are evaluated a second time - if deemed successful, they can claim up to an additional **CHF 8'000** to support organization of third party funds for the ramp-up.




DESIGN THINKING HELPS CREATE RADICAL INNOVATION


